150, entitled, an act to extend the powers of the commissioners of the school fund in Queen Anne's county, and to encourage the establishment of free schools in said county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third

time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to divorce Albert G. Franciscus, and his wife Eliza G. Franciscus, of the city of Baltimore,

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house

of delegates.

Mr. Osborn from the committee to which leave was granted reported a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Robert H. Hays, of Cecil.county.

Which was read the first, and by special order the third time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Osborn, read the third time by specirl order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer the bill entitled, an act relating to appeals from the county courts.

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to provide for the opening of a road therein mentioned.

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the bill entitled, an act concerning the justices of the orphans court of Allegany county, was being read the third time, when

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the following amendments were read and assented to:

In the 5th line, of 1st section, strike out the words 'twenty five cents,' and insert 'twelve and a half cents.'

At the end of the 1st section add:

"Provided, that itinerant compensation by the mile shall not be charged more than once for each and every term of the court"

The bill was then read through, passed and sent to the house of delegates.
