

co. comprehending election districts, Nos. one and two, as each of said districts is known, designated, marked out and bounded, shall compose the second district; all that part of Cecil county comprehending election districts, numbers three and four, as each of said districts is now known, designated, maked out and bounded; Harford county, and all that part of Baltimore county comprehending election districts Nos. four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve, as they are known, designated, marked out and bounded, shall compose the third district; that the residue of Baltimore county, the city of Baltimore, and all that part of Frederick county comprehending election districts, numbers two, six, seven and eleven, as they are now known, designated, marked out and bounded, shall compose the fourth district, and all that part of Frederick county comprehending election districts, numbers one, eight and nine, Montgomery county and Anne Arundel county, and the city of Annapolis, shall compose the fifth district, that the residue of Frederick county, Washington county and Allegany county, shall compose the sixth district.

2nd, In the 5th line, 3rd page, 1st section, strike out the word "eighth," an insert "seventh."

3rd. Add at the end of the first section these words, "except the fourth district shall be entitled to two representatives in Congress."
