Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, and act supplementary to an act passed December session 1826, chapter 128, relating to the preservation of the breed of fish in the Patuxent river, reported favorably thereon.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the extension of Light street in the city of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read and assented to:
