Add at the end of the bill the following section:

"And be it enacted, That this act shall continue and be in force until the end of the year eighteen hundred and forty five, and until the end of the session of the general assembly next thereafter."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Dennis the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Benjamin Wilson of Queen Anne's county,

Was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, a further supplement to an act passed at December session 1831, chapter 323, entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves.

Ordered, That Messrs. Mayer, Dennis and Emory be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Mayer from the said committee reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to an act passed at December session 1831, chapter 323, entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves.

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Mayer leave was granted to bring in a bill to be entitled, a supplement to the act passed at December session 1810, chapter 34, relating to devises and legacies.

Ordered, That Messrs. Mayer, Pigman and Dennis be a committee to prepare and report the same.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 9 o'clock.
