

In the 5th line of the 61st section, after the word "for" where it first occurs, insert the words "for a period of time not less than three, nor more than."

In the 13th line of the same section after the word "prescribed," strike out the remainder of the section.

Strike out the 64th section and insert the following.

"And be it enacted, That each officer for each and every day he shall attend said drill, shall be entitled to receive from the treasurer of the western shore, the sum of two dollars, out of any money in the treasury on account of militia fines, provided there be any such."

In the 13th line of the 1st section, after the word "tutors," insert the words, "and students."

The bill was then read through the second and by special order the third time, and the question was put "Shall the bill pass?"
