of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments, which were read the first time.

1st section 20th line after the word eleven, strike out the words "twelve, thirteen and fourteen," and insert "and all that part of district No. 3, which may by force of an act passed this general assembly at its present session be laid off as a separate district and designated No. 14.

24th line same section strike out the words "three and ten" and insert "ten, twelve and so much of district No 3, as may not be laid out and designated as No. 14, and which has not by this act been made a part of the sixth congressional district."

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the judges of electi its now appointed or hereafter to be appointed under the corporation of the city of Baltimore, in wards number in said city, in making the returns for representatives in congress under this act, shall designate therein, that the said wards at which they presided as judges are part of district No.

as laid out by law, to choose a member to represent this state in the congress of the United States.

4. And be it enacted, That the mayor of the city of Baltimore for the time being shall cause public notice to be given of the elections for representatives in congress under this act, in all newspapers in the city of Baltimore in the same manner as provided for in any act or acts to which

this act is an additional supplement.

5. And be it enacted, That if at any time hereafter a special or extra session of congress should be called to commence at such period as to make it necessary in the opinion on of the governor and council that the representatives in congress for this state should be chosen before the time fixed by law for such election, then it shall be the duty of the governor by proclamation published in the newspapers throughout the state and otherwise at least thirty days before the time to be appointed for the election by said proclamation, to appoint a day for the election as aforesaid of said representatives in congress, on which day said election shall accordingly be held to the same effect and in the same manner and under the same regulations as in case of elections of said representatives on the days fixed by law.
