A bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county,

A bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act entitled, "an act to provide for electing commissioners for Baltimore county, and prescribing their powers and duties.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Anne Tomkins and William Tomkins.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Osborn, Emory and Mayer.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate Cambridge Lodge No. 66, of Free and Accepted Masons, in Dorchester county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Dennis, Sappington and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1829, chapter 87, entitled, an act to promote the preservation, improvement, and increase of shell fish in this state.

A bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act passed at December session 1832, entitled, an act to repeal an act to abolish imprisonment for debt, on certain judgments rendered by justices of the peace, passed at December session 1830, chapter 155,
