A bill entitled, an act to build a clerk's office, and register's office for Prince George's county, or enlargement of the present offices,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Pigman and Hughlett.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish a library for the use of the legislature,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the library.

A bill entitled, an act for the payment of the journal of recounts,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, an act to facilitate the collection and improve the revenue of this state,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on finance.

And returned the following bills which originated in

the senate severally endorsed, "will pass."

A bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Washington County bank at the town of Williamsport in Washington county, and

A bill entitled, an act relating to Westminster, '1 a-

ney Town and Emmittsburgh turnpike company.

Mr. Dennis from the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Frederick county court to record certain deeds therein mentioned, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order, the third time rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The resolution in favor of Kent county Academy was read the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The senate adjourned until 5 o'clock, P. M.
