Mr. Claude submitted the following report,

Which was read and concurred in:

"The joint committee on the public printing report, That in compliance with the provisions of the act passed at the last session on that subject they have contracted with William M'Neir to execute the printing which may be required by the senate; and with Jeremiah Hughes to execute the printing of the laws, and such work as may be required by the house of delegates, for the ensuing year.
