A bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to allow an additional compensation to James Taylor, for building a bridge over the Monocacy river,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Pigman and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of John Gauer,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Page and Montgomery.

The bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed of conveyance therein mentioned,

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and detective proceedings.

Mr. Claude submitted the following message:
