On motion of Mr. Wootton, leave was g. Messrs. Wootton, Pigman and Wilson, to prepare report a bill to be entitled, an act to incorparate the I tapsco Female Institution.

On motion of Mr. Wilson, the hill entitled an act to incorporate the Choptank Steam Boat and Navigation. Company of Maryland, was taken up for consideration.

The bill was progressing in the third reading, when On motion of Mr. Wootton, the following amendment was read and assented to:

In the 6th. line of the 11th section, after the work. "State" strike out the remainder of the section.

The bill was then read through, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Female Institution.

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10

SATURDAY, January 18th, 1834.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

Mr. Emory appeared in the Senate Chamber and resumed his seat.
