Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Mayer and Emory.

A bill entitled, An act to incorporate the Washington Beneficial Society of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Osborn.

A bill entitled, An act to distribute the School Fund of Allegany county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Groome and Mayer.

A bill entitled, A supplement to an act entitled, An act to incorporate the Beaver Dam and Harrington's Branch and Canal Company.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

A bill entitled. An act authorising the sale of land therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the bill entitled. A further supplement to an act entitled, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany, which originated in the senate, endorsed "will pass."

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which had been referred the bill entitled, An act to authorise appraisers on real or personal estate to qualify each other, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion that it ought not to pass.

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time and rejected.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings to which leave had been granted, reported a bill
