The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 e'clock.

SATURDAY, January 25, 1834.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill entitled, an act to appoint Mary Jordan of Harford county, trustee for the sale of certain land there in mentioned, and

The bill entitled, an act to authorise appraisers on real or personal estate to qualify each other, severally rejected by the Senate on yesterday, were returned to the House of Delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted him to withdraw the petition of Godfrey Meyer and others, praying for an incorporation of a National Infirmary upon the Thomsonian System.

The petition was accordingly withdrawn.

Mr. Mayer, from the committee to which leave had been granted, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act passed at December session 1831, chapter 86, entitled, an act to authorise the making a general Alphabetical Index of the Land Records of Baltimore county, from the year seventeen hundred and ninetynine inclusive, and to keep up such Index henceforth.
