

On motion of Mr. Mayer, leave was granted to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Pigman, to report a bill to be entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the despatch of business in Baltimore county court.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the resolution relative to the pay of committees appointed to visit and inspect public works, &c. was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the following amendment was read and assented to:

The resolutions was then read the third time by special order assented to as amended and returned to the House of Delegates.
