Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to authorise Thomas E. Hamilton, executor, to make sale of the real estate therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over the Monocacy river, passed at December session, 1823, chapter 67,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Pigman and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal part of an act, passed at December session, 1824, chapter 167, authorising gates to be kept on the public roads, in Queen Anne's county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Hughlett and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of Samuel P. Smith, and Reuben Worthington, of Allegany county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Chapman and Osborn.
