

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Frederick county to levy a sum of money to erect a bridge over Toms creek, near the village of Emmitsburgh.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Hughlett and Osborn.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Francina Kidd, from her husband, James Taylor Kidd.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on divorces.

A bill entitled, an act relating to division fences between different proprietors in Kent county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Osborn, Montgomery and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to repeal so much of the act of December session, 1823, as relates to the lands of Sarah Wilkinson, of Queen Anne's county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Morris and Wilson.

A bill entitled, an act regulating fences in Dorchester and Caroline counties.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Hughlett, Claude and Groome.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate entitled, an act to incorporate the Patapsco Female Institute, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment."

Which amendment was read.
