"Provided that the whole amount of stock and weekly deposites of any member, shall at no time exceed in value the sum of two thousand dollars, as provided in the original charter."

The bill was then read through, passed and returned to the House of Delegates.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a petition from sundry citizens of Washington county relative to an increase of the jurisdiction of the Justices of the Peace of said county.

Which was read and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

Also a resolution relative to the postage of the members of the Legislature.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Finance.

Also a bill entitled, an act to prevent partiality in sales by auction of deceased persons estates.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

And returned the following bills, which originated in the Senate, severally endorsed "will pass."

The bill entitled, an act to change the name of Marion Hollyday of Washington county, to that of Nancy Ringold Hollyday, and

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Port Deposite Rail Road company.

The President announced the order of the day, being the bill enlitted, an act to restrain the owners of vesseis from navigating the same under the sole command of negroes.

The bill was being read the third time, when On motion of Mr. Morris,
