"Will the senate assent to the proposed amendment?"

And it was determined in the negative:

The bill was then read through and ordered to be engressed for a third reading.

Mr. Hughlett presented the report of the trustees of the Academy at Easton, in Talbot county, made in compliance with the resolution of December session, 1827.

Which was read and referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10. o'clock.

SATURDAY, February 1st, 1834.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The message received yesterday from his Excellency Governor Thomas, communicating the annual report of the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, and

A report of the Board of Managers for removing the people of color, and

A report of the Trustees of the Academy at Easton, severally referred yesterday to the consideration of the House of Delegates, were sent to the House of Delegates.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a bill
