election of a Director on the part of the state in the Bank of Baltimore.

The ballot box was prepared, and the ballots deposited therein; and on examination thereof by the clerk, it appeared there had been 11 votes given, all of which were for George C. Morton.

Whereupon it was declared that George C. Morton, esquire, is duly elected a Director on the part of the state in the Bank of Baltimore for the present year.

Mr. Groome from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to build a bridge over North East Creek near North East in Cecil county, on the main road from North East to Charles Town, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments.

Which were read and assented to:

In the 5th, line of 1st. section after the word "authorise," insert "by and with the consent and under the direction of the commissioners of Cecil county."

In the 1st, line of 2d, section, after the word "authorised," insert "at their discretion."

In the 15th line of 3d section, after the word "commissioners," insert "if the said county commissioners should consent to the erection of said bridge."

The bill was then read the second time.

The President laid before the Senate the following communication from the Treasurer of the Western Shore.
