"Provided, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to confer authority on the directors or stockholders by any rule or by-law, to restrict or limit the number of weekly depositors who may desire to deposit or become members of said corporation, provided the amount made by each depositor be not less than the minimum sum of one dollar per week; and that they in all things comply with the provisions of this act, and the rules and by-laws which may from time to time be adopted."
