Mr. Mayer, from the committee to which the leave was granted reported a bill entitled, an act relating to justices of the peace in and for Baltimore city.

Which was read the first time:

Mr. Wilson, from the committee on colored population to which was referred the bill entitled, an act authorising the clerk of St. Marys' county to register two negro slaves, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment;

Which was read and assented to:

At the end of 1st section add.

"And that said Ignatius Millard, hath an estate in said negroes, to take effect after the death of said Bennett Grenwell, and that said Greenwell hath no power to defeat such estate."

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Groome from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act for the relief of Creditors and to prevent frauds and deceits occasioned by secret sales, mortgages, and gifts of goods and chattels.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for building a bridge over North East creek in Cecil county near M Cauley's nall, reported lavorably thereon.
