lanes and alleys in the city of Baltimore, severally passed by the senate on Friday, and

The bill entitled, an act authorising the clerk of St. Marys' county, to register two negro slaves, and

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to reduce the width of a part of Poppleton street in said city, also passed by the senate on Friday, with certain amendments, and

The bill entitled, an act to restrain the owners of vessels from navigating the same under the sole command of negroes, and

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act passed December session 1816, chapter 199, regulating the cording of fire wood in the city of Baltimore, severally rejected by the senate on Saturday, and

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Bever Dam and Harrington's Branch and Canal Company, passed by the senate on Saturday, and

The bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed therein mentioned, also passed by the senate on Saturday, with certain amendments, were returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee on judicial proceedings to which the leave was granted reported a bill entitled, an act relating to evidence.

Which was read the first time.

On motion of Mr. Hughlett,

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money for finishing Washington Academy in Somerset county and for other purposes, passed at November session 1803, chapter 87.

Which was passed by the senate on Saturday, was reconsidered and ordered to lie on the table.
