

On motion of Mr. Groome,

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate Prince Frederick Town Academy, in Calvert county, passed at December session 1832, chapter 246, was read the third time by special order, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled an act relating to the records of conveyances in the several counties in this state.

Which was read the first time

The bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled an act for the relief of creditors and to prevent frauds and deceits occasioned by secret sales, mortgages and gifts of goods and chattels.

Was read the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Chapman submitted the following resolution,

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the governor be authorised and requested to employ an engineer to make a survey with a view to ascertain the practicability and probable cost of cutting a Canal from the head of tide water of Wicomico River at or near Allen's Fresh to Bryan Town in Charles county.*

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and rejected.
