A bill entitled, a supplement to the act to provide for the public instruction of youth in primary schools throughout the state.

A bill entitled, an act to confirm the proceedings of certain commissioners in Somerset county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wilson, Page and Hughlett.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce James W. Collins, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Sarah Collins.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on divorces.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the sale of real estate therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act for founding a college in the city of Frederick, passed at December session 1829; chapter 83.
