

The bill entitled, an act for building a bridge over Little North East Creek, in Cecil county, near McCaul-ey's Mill, was being read the third time, when

On motion of Mr. Groome, the following amendments were read and assented to:

After the word "commissioners" in the 4th line of the first section insert the words "are hereby authorised by and with the consent and under the direction of the commissioners of Cecil county."

"In the 2d line of the 2d section, after the word "authorised," insert the words "at their discretion."

In the 1st line of the 3d section, after the word "commissioners" insert the words "if the said county commissioners should consent to the erection of said bridge."

The bill was then read through and passed.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to provide for the cession of the territorial jurisdiction of this state, over certain land on Love Point, in Queen Anne's county, to the United States for the erection of a Light House thereon, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and passed.
