It was ordered, that when the senate adjourn, it shall beand adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the despatch of business in Baltimore county county count, was read the third time and passed.

Mr. Chapman from the committee on finance, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act concerning the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time and passed.

His Excellency Governor Thomas, appeared in the Senate Chamber.

On motion of Mr. Emory,

It was ordered, that Messrs Emory and Claude, inform the house of delegates that the Governor is in readiness to sign and seal the engrossed bills and request their attendance to witness that ceremony.

Mr. Emory and Mr. Claude, left the senate chamber, and after a short time returned and stated that they had performed the duty assigned them.

Accordingly the Honorable Speaker and Members of the house of delegates appeared in the Senate Chamber.

When His Excellency Governor Thomas, signed the engrossed bills from No. 1, to No. 73 inclusive, in conformity with the provisions of the Constitution and form of Government.

The Honorable Speaker and Members of the house of delegates, then retired from the Senate Chamber.
