

Which were read and assented to:

In the 5th line of the enacting clause;

Strike out the word "another" and insert the words "this or any other."

At the end of the bill insert:

"From the party owing or holding such slave."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee on colored population to which was referred the bill entitled an act relating to persons of color who are free after the expiration of a term of years, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Emory presented the petition of Isaac Leo.

Which was read and referred to the committee on colored population.

Mr. Emory from the committee on colored population to which said petition was referred, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to people of color of this state.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for electing the levy court of Queen Anne's county by the people, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass, with the following amendments.
