

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Pigman from the committee on insolvency, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Benjamin Childs and Isaac Smith Homans, of the city of Baltimore, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

Also a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the President and Managers of the Thompsonian National Infirmary.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Wilson and Sappington.
