Leave was granted to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Wilson, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the Maryland Savings Institution.

Mr. Emory presented a petition of sundry citizens of Queen Anne's county, relative to the evils of intemperance on the black population of the county.

Which was read and referred to the committee on colored population

On motion of Mr. Morris,

The resolution submitted by him on yesterday, making it the duty of the geologist to report to the Visitors of St. John's College, the result of any and every analysis that he may be required to make under the 4th section of an act entitled, an act to provide for making a new and complete map and geological survey of the state.

Was read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Mayer

Amended by adding the following resolution.

And be it further resolved, that the geologist be and he is hereby required to set apart for and furnish also to the other colleges of this state, all such geological specimens as it may be practicable for him to turnish after appropriating to St. John's college the specimens mentioned in the aforegoing resolution.

The resolutions were then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an act relating to mortgages.

Was read the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Emory from the committee on colored population to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise Albert Battle, a free man of color of the state of Virginia, to remove and resure in the state of Maryland, reported favorably thereon.
