The bill entitled, an act to authorise Albert Battle, a free man of color to remove to and reside in the state of Maryland, severally passed by the senate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Morris,

Leave was granted to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to repeal an act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county, and the several supplements thereto.

The resolutions relative to the Southern and Western boundaries of this state.

Were read the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate a company of make a turnpike road from such point as the Somerset and Cumberland turnpike company of Pennsylvania, shall fix upon at the Pennsylvania line, to the public square in the town of Cumberland, so as to intersect with the United States Road, commonly called the National Road, at such point as may be most convenient and practicable, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act relating to Monument street, in the city of Baltimore.

Was read the third time passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent partiality in sales by auction of deceased persons estates, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass.
