Which were severally read the first time and reserved to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act incorporating a company to make a turnpike road from Williams Port to Hagers town.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

A bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to erect Baltimore county into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messis. Mayer, Morris and Montgomery.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of George Fouke and Elizabeth his wife, and Henry and Lewis Fouke.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the cession of the territorial jurisdiction of this state, over certain land on Piney Point in St. Mary's county, for the election of a Light House thereon.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messis. Wootton, Sappington and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of James Todd and Eber F. Cook, of the city of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act passed at December session 1828, chapter 34, authorising the levy court of Frederick county to levy an additional sum of money to erect a bridge over the Monocaey River at Lilly's Ford.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messis. Sappington, Wilson and Groome.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Lailieure United Fire Department.
