A bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county to allow to Richard English of said county, a certain sum of money by him claimed.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messis. Sappington, Pigman and Morris.

A bill entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Christian Artz of Frederick county to Christian Burr Artz.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Montgomery and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to unite Middletown, Keller's Addition, Gaove's Addition to Middletown and Wise's Addition to Middletown into one, by the name of Middletown and incorporate the same.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Pigman and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act for the reassessment and revaluation of all the real and personal property in Cecil county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Groome, Chapman and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act to lay out and open a road in Montgomery county, passed at December session 1832, chapter 212.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Wootton and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the measuring of tan bark in the city of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Morris, Pigman and Sappington.

On motion of Mr. Chapman, he was excused from serving on the committee to which had been referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act to establish a bank in the District of Columbia.
