Mr. Groome from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the reassessment and revaluation of all the real and personal property in Cecil county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment.

Which was read and assented to:

In the 2nd line, of the 9th section, insert after the word "die" "or shall neglect or refuse to act."

The bill was then read the second and by special order the third time and passed.

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered a resolution authorising the Governor to call out a portion of the militia to suppress a riot on the Baltimore and Washington Rail Road.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the militia.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Maryland Type and Stereotype Company, endorsed, "will pass."

Mr. Sappington from the committee on the militia to which was referred the resolution authorising the Governor to call out a portion of the militia to suppress a riot on the Baltimore and Washington Rail Road, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, and assented to.

The Senate adjourned until to morrow morning 10 o'clock.
