

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate a Fire Insurance Company in the city of Baltimore, passed December 23d, 1807, chapter 68.

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act, for the preservation of wild fowl in the waters of Swan Creek, Spesutie Narrows, Rumney Creek, Bush River, and Gunpowder River; in Harford County.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Hughlett and Mayer.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act to make sale of the poors house and public lands thereto, belonging in Talbot county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Hughlett, Pigman and Sappington.

A bill entitled, a further supplement to an act relating to the people of color in this state, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 281.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on colored population.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act for the relief of William Gowins, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment."

Which amendment was read and adopted.

And was as follows:

At the end of the bill add the following proviso:

"Provided that nothing herein contained shall defeat the rights of the creditors of said Gowins."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Maryland Steam Boat Company, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment."
