

Which amendment was read and adopted.

And was as follows:

At the end of the bill, add the following section:

Section 11. And be it enacted, That the state hereby reserves the right to impose such tax on the funds of said company, as may be imposed on similar property within the state."

On motion of Mr. Pigman,

Leave was granted to the committee on insolvency, to prepare and report a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors of this state, passed at November session, 1805, chapter 110.

Provided that at least one week's notice in the newspapers of said city, (the cost of the advertisements to be paid by the applicants) be given of such application before any such ordinance shall pass.
