

The bill entitled, an act to improve the navigation of the Western Branch of Patuxent River, in Prince Georges county.

Was read the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to the act for the valuation of real and personal property in Anne Arundel county.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Wootton,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act authorising the levy court of Caroline county, to levy into the hands of the President and Directors of the Denton Bridge Company, the sum of fifty dollars, for the purpose of keeping in good order and repair the causeway leading from the village of Denton to Denton Bridge, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass, with the following amendment.

Which was read and assented to:

At the end of the bill add:

Provided that this law shall have no force or effect until the assent of the president and directors, or the stockholders or stockholder owning the stock of the company incorporated for building a bridge over Choptank River, at or near Denton Ferry, be delivered to the levy court in writing, and the said assent of the said president and directors, or the stockholders or stockholder owning said stock, be recorded in the book containing the proceedings of said court.
