A bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Snow Hill, in Worcester county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Wilson, Morris and Sappington.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Boonsborough, Slifer's Addition, Holler's Addition, and Allabpugh's Addition to Boonsborough, in Washington county, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 139.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Emory and Pigman.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the preservation of deer in Washington and Allegany counties, passed at November session 1795.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Sappington and Wilson.

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the Central Savings Institution of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Morris, Groome and Wootton.

A bill entitled, an act to prevent the destruction of oysters in the waters of this state.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Emory, Claude and Wootton.
