

In the second reason, after the word "treasury" in the 12th line, strike out the remainder of the sentence and insert, "and for reasons satisfactory to both houses of congress."

In the 4th reason, strike out "such" and insert "the."

Strike out the 5th reason.

In the 6th strike out "arbitrary and unlawful."

Strike out the 7th reason.

In the 8th reason, strike out "waiting to ascertain" and insert "further inquiry."

Strike out "illegal and unjustifiable," and insert "in."

In the amendments, strike out all after the word "people," in the 4th line.

The resolutions were then read the second time, and

Ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

On motion of Mr. Morris,

The senate proceeded to the consideration of the unfinished business of yesterday, being the bill entitled, an act to alter and amend certain parts of the constitution and form of government.

The first section was read, and

Mr. Emory moved that the question be put separately on each section. Accordingly the question was put,

"Will the senate adopt the said section?"

And it was determined in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr. Emory,

The following was inserted as the second section;

And be it enacted, that all votes hereafter to be given by members of the General Assembly shall be viva voce and not by ballot.
