

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road from the Greenfield Mill in Frederick county to the neighborhood of Clarksburgh in Montgomery county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Wootton and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Worcester county, to appoint commissioners for certain purposes therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs, Wilson, Hughlett and Emory.

A bill entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Sophia Anne Weare, of Washington county, to the name of Sophia Elizabeth Shaw.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Sappington and Emory.

And returned the bill which originated in the senate entitled, an act for the benefit of Albertina Anna Neilson, of the city of Baltimore, endorsed, "will pass."

Also returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to promote internal improvement, by the construction of a Rail Road from Baltimore to the city of Washington, and for other purposes, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were read and adopted, and were as follows:

In section 1st, 18th line, strike out the words "private and."

In same section, 20th line, strike out the words "private and.;"

In second section, first line, strike out Richard G. Stocket and insert in lieu thereof "Dennis Gaither."

In same section and first and second lines strike out John G. Proud, Allen Thomas, and insert "Benjamin Brown Bushrod W. Marriott," in lieu thereof.
