On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The bill entitled, an act to alter and amend certain parts of the constitution and form of government, was reconsidered and

On motion of Mr. Wootton,

The question was put,

Will the senate agree to strike out all of the bill after the enacting clause?"

And it was determined in the affirmative.

So the bill was rejected.

The president announced the order of the day, being the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county, and the several supplements thereto.

The amendments heretofore reported, was being read,

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 e'clock.
