It was read the second and by special order the third time and passed.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act relative to justices of the peace and for other purposes, passed at December session, 1814, was read the third time and passed.

Mr. Claude from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Annapolis Savings Fund, passed at December session, 1832, chapter 30.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore United Fire Department.

Was read the third time and passed.

On motion of Mr. Morris,

The senate resumed the consideration of the unfinished business of the forenoon, being the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county, and the several supplements thereto.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The following amendment was read:

Strike out all of the bill after the enacting clause, and insert:

That so much of the fifth section of the act passed at December session of the year eighteen hundred and thirty one, chapter two hundred and fifty eight, and of the act to which this is a supplement or of any supplement thereto, as directs any assessment, levy or taxation upon income or earnings be and the same is hereby repealed: Provided however that nothing herein contained shall be construed to discharge the liability of any person for taxes now incur-
