red by virtue of any assessment and levy heretofore made on property under said act or any supplement thereto.

Section 2. And be it enacted, The tax which may hereafter be levied for the purposes of the act to which this is a supplement or of any of the supplements thereto shall not hereafter in any year exceed the rate of twenty cents per hundred dollars on any property to be assessed, and that all such parts of the said act or of any supplement thereto as are inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

On motion of Mr. Pigman,

The bill and amendment were ordered to lie on the table.
