

A bill entitled, an act to alter and change the dividing lines between the first and fifth election districts in Montgomery county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Claude and Wilson.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of William Harness, of Allegany county.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Groome and Mayer.

And returned the following bills which originated in the senate, severally endorsed, "will pass."

The bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to the city of Baltimore, passed at December session, 1817.

The bill entitled, an act relating to Hamburgh street, in the city of Baltimore.

Also returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to revive and amend the act entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the regulation and improvement of the town of Cumberland, in Allegany county, and to incorporate the same, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments:

Which amendments were read, and were as follows:

In the 2d section, 8th line, strike out after the word "election," the following words, "and having paid a county tax within that time and after the first election a corporation tax in lieu of the county tax."

In 3d line of the same section, strike out the word "three" and insert in lieu thereof the word "five."

In 4th line, same section, after the word "dollars" insert "as valued on the county assessment."

In the 7th and 8th lines of the 3d section, strike out the words "five hundred" and insert in lieu the words "one thousand."
