In the 8th line same section, after the word "dollars" insert "as valued in the county assessment."

At the end of the bill add as the 6th section:

And be it enacted, That the limits of the said town for all purposes, except taxation by the laws of the corporation, shall be as follows: half a mile in every direction all round the town to be computed and measured from the town lots on the outer edge or confines, of the town proper, as located and settled by law, and by the plat already recorded among the records of Allegany county.

Also returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act for opening and increasing the width of German Lane, in the city of Baltimore, passed at December session 1831, chapter 301, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were read and adopted:

And were as follows:

After the word "oath" 8th line 2d section add "or affirmation."

After the word "oath" 10th line same section add "or affirmation."

Also returned the bill which originated in senate, entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Neptune Insurance Company, endorsed "will not pass."

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act concerning the amendment of judicial proceedings.

Was read the third time passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Wootton from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the resolutions relative to the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal, reported that the committee had had said resolutions under consideration and were of opinion they ought to be assented to with the following amendaments.
