It was read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Sappington from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act authorising the laying out and opening a road through Frederick and Baltimore counties, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to prevent the destruction of oysters in this state, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time passed and return ed to the house of delegates.

Mr. Hughlett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to the act to provide for the public instruction of Youth in primary schools throughout this state, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments.

Which were read and assented to:

Section 2. In the 7th line after the word 'clerk,' strike out to the word 'the' in the 8th line.

After the word county in said line, strike out 'schedule of,' and insert 'and shall proceed to levy upon.'

10th line after the word 'district,' strike out 'shall proceed to levy.'

Section 5. In the 4th line strike out 'commissioners,' and insert after the word 'schools,' 'for Talbot county in the Branch of the Farmers Bank of Maryland at Easton.

Section 6. In the 5th line after the word "of," strike out the remainder of the section, and insert 'to that county to be by them deposited in the Branch of the Farmers Bank of Maryland at Easton, for the use of the primary schools for Talbot county.'
