Section 3. And be it enacted, That from and after the first day of September next, in every case of supersedeas upon judgments either of justices of the peace of the city of Baltimore or of Baltimore county court, the surety or sureties in such supersedeas, shall beside acknowledging themselves bound for the judgments aforesaid, sign a certificate of such acknowledgment which shall be deemed and taken as part of the record of such supersedeas, and that if such surety or sureties shall be incapable of writing his name, the justices or other persons taking such supersedeas shall certify their being satisfied either of their own knowledge or by oral
