Were read and assented to.

The resolution was then read the second and by special order the third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The amendments proposed by the house of delegates to the bill entitled, an act to revive and amend the act entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Cumberland, in Allegany county, and to incorporate the same.

Were read and assented to.

On motion of Mr. Sappington,

The bill entitled, an act entitled, a further supplement to the several acts of assembly, for the regulation and government of the militia of this state.
