A resolution relative to the act of congress organising the militia.

And a resolution authorising the Governor and Council to contract for the building of a gun house in the city of Annapolis.

Which were severally read the first time, and referred to the committee on the militia.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of Visitors and Governors of the Jail, of Baltimore county, and to prescribe their powers and duties.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Morris, Mayer, and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act to abolish all such parts of the constitution and form of government, as relate to the time and manner of electing the Senate, and the mode of filling up vacancies in that body, so that each county and the city of Baltimore, may have a senator to be elected immediately by the people.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Mayer and Sappington.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Catharine Boss, from her husband Samuel S. Boss.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on divorces.

And returned the following bills which originated in the senate, severally endorsed 'will pass.'
