A bill entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, passed at December session 1823, chapter 125.

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Sappington, Pigman and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act relating to jail fees, of runaway negroes, in Prince Georges county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Claude and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the repairs of a bridge over the Patapsco Falls, at Elliott's Old Upper Mills.

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Claude, Mayer and Morris.

A bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a road in Anne Arundel county.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to continue in force the acts of assembly, which would expire with the present session.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the clerk of Prince Georges county court, to record a certain deed therein mentioned.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the following bills, which originated in the senate, severally endorsed, 'will not pass.'

The bill entitled, an act to extend to the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road Company, certain privileges and powers heretofore granted to the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company.
