county court, to record the deed therein mentioned, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second and by special order the third time rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to the people of color of this state.

Was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to secure the mechanics and others, payment for labor done, and materials furnished in the erection or repairs of buildings and machinery, or either of them in this state.

Was read the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others.

Was read the third time and passed,

With the following amendment:

Strike out all of the last line of the first section, and insert the words "of an ordinary, tavern or public inn."

The bill was then passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Mayer,

The amendment heretofore reported to the bill entitled, an act relating to superscdeus and fieri fucius in this state.

Was read and assented to.

The bill was then read, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to continue in force the acts of assembly, which would ex-
